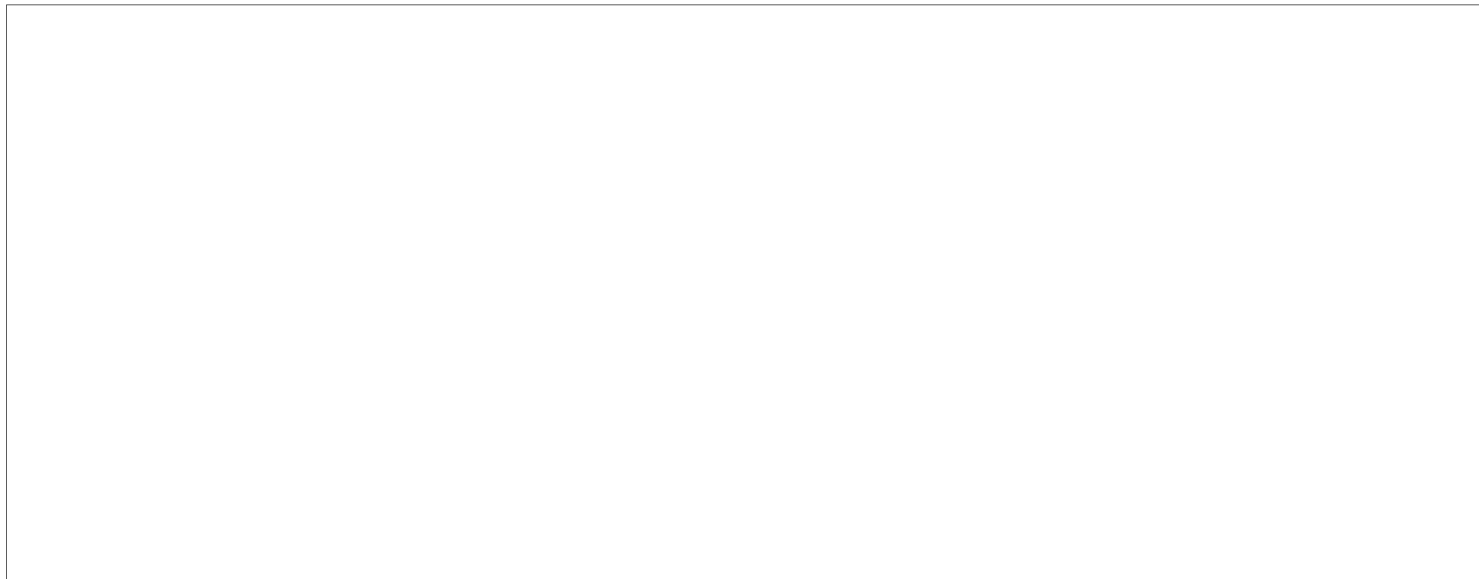

SUBJECT: Rebuilding the International Consensus for a Strong Nonproliferation Regime

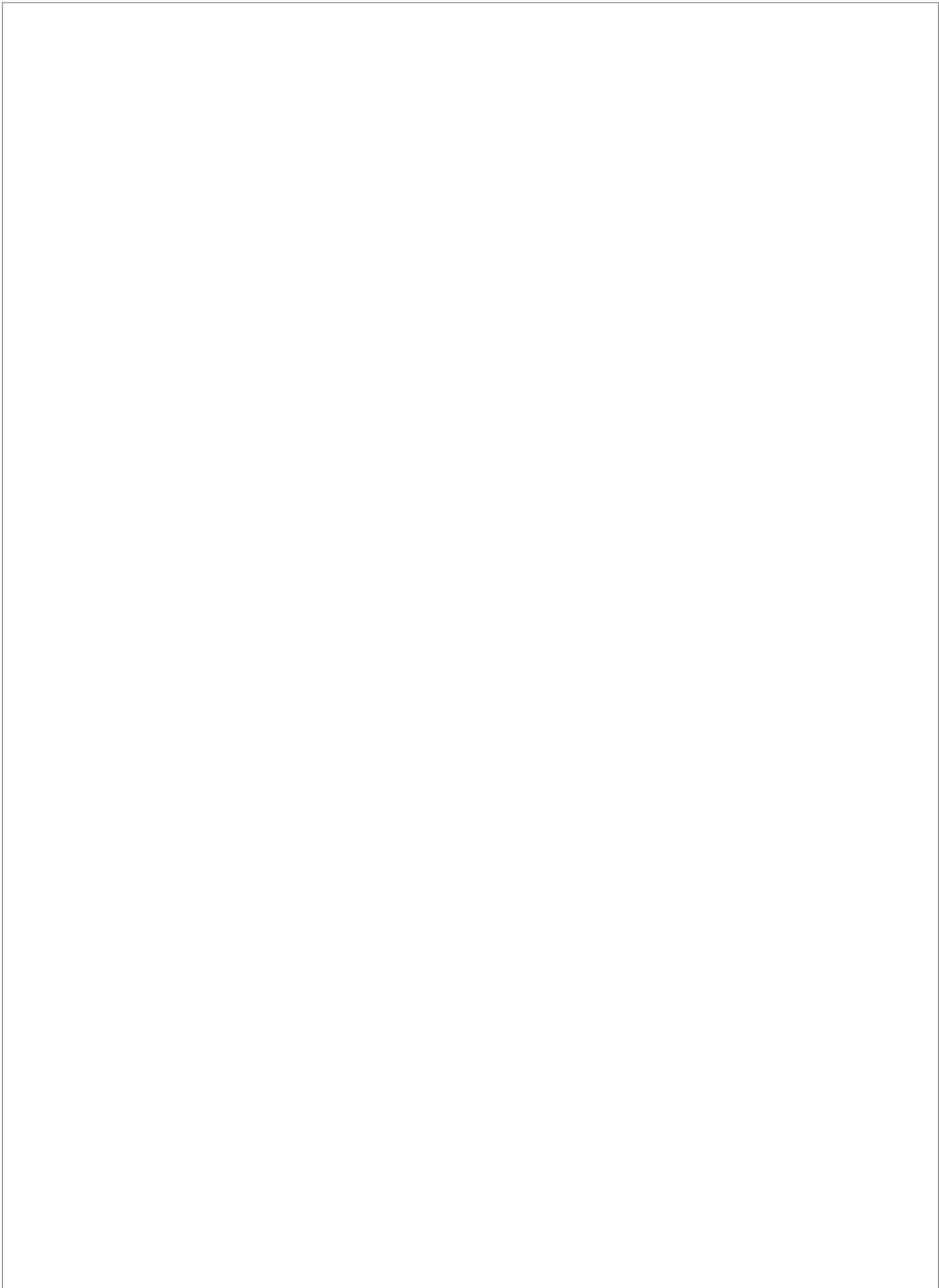

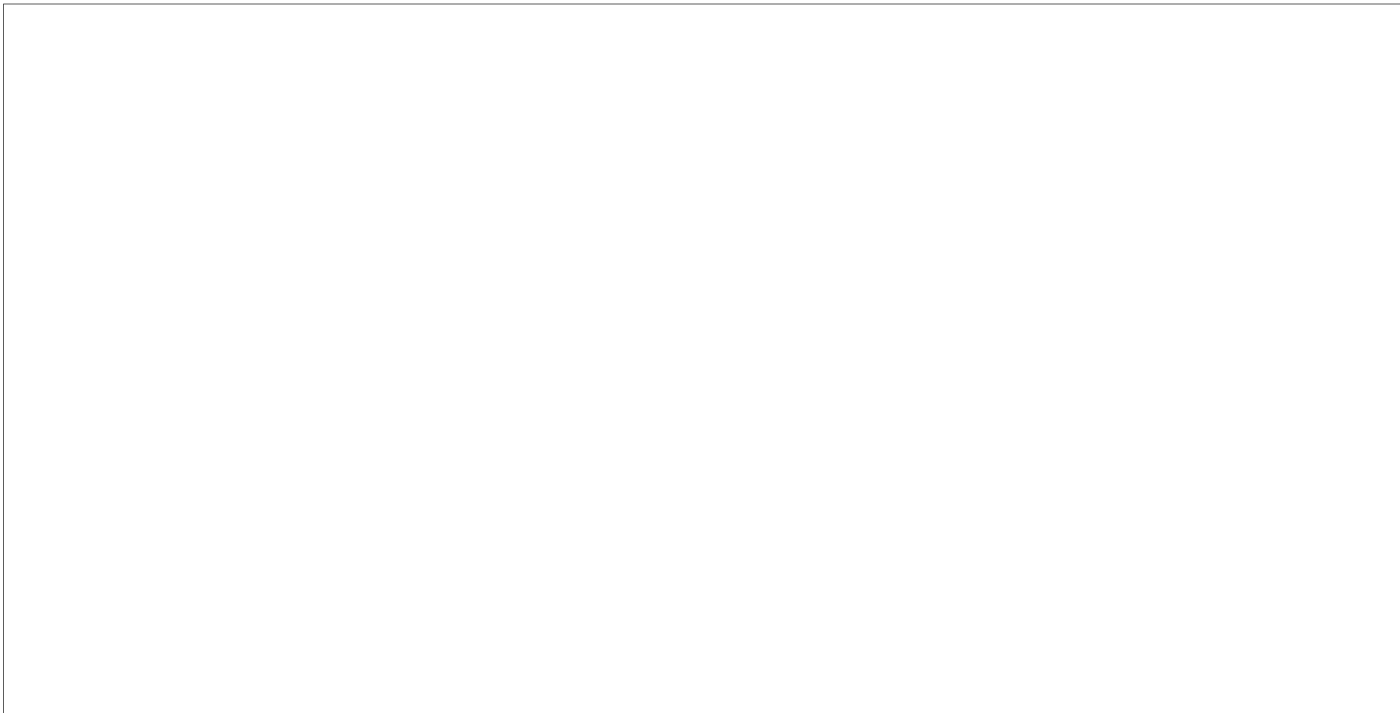
Promoting the President's agenda for reducing nuclear threats worldwide is clearly a USG-wide effort.

campaign pledges, nearly all of them are diplomatic undertakings, e.g.:

- Eliminate all loose nuclear materials around the world in four years;
- Reduce the stockpile: Negotiate dramatic reductions in the stockpiles of U.S./Russian weapons and material;
- Implement a global ban on the production of fissile material for weapons;
- Strengthen NPT so that nations that don't comply automatically face strong sanctions; and,
- Establish an international fuel bank to back up commercial supplies to remove excuses for national uranium enrichment plants.
