Lead Fatah reconciliation negotiator Azzam al-Ahmed confirmed from Cairo a minute ago that Hamas agreed to allow the Central Elections Commission to begin preparatory work in Gaza on May 27. The shift in Hamas's position removes the most recent brake in the intra-Palestinian reconciliation process; the reasons for Hamas's shift are not yet clear. (We doubt internal Hamas elections played a significant role as they have not yet concluded, so external factors are more likely.)

The move paves the way for consultations to begin on the interim government of technocrats envisioned in the Doha reconciliation deal. EGIS has put out a statement confirming the key points, which should hit the wires soon.
