Minister Wardak called SecDef just now to offer his deepest condolences. Wardak said he was assembling the religious leaders, parliamentarians, justices of the supreme court, and senior staff at the Palace to work urgently to stem the violence against coalition personnel.

SecDef said he appreciated the call and urged Wardak to take all necessary means to prevent this sort of violence. As you know, General Allen has taken several immediate steps to protect our people.
