Quote from a readout of Netanyahu's meeting with senior advisers on Friday:

"Everyone knows that restrained and moderate construction in Judea and Samaria in the next year will no even affect the peace process. Therefore the international community needs to call on the Palestinians to continue engaging in peace talks. It is in the interest of the Palestinians just as it is in ours"... "We did it [the moratorium] in order to give the opportunity to enter
