The second paper is a project that will start in the next month involving the Internal Medicine Residency in partnership with the Association of Black Cardiologists.

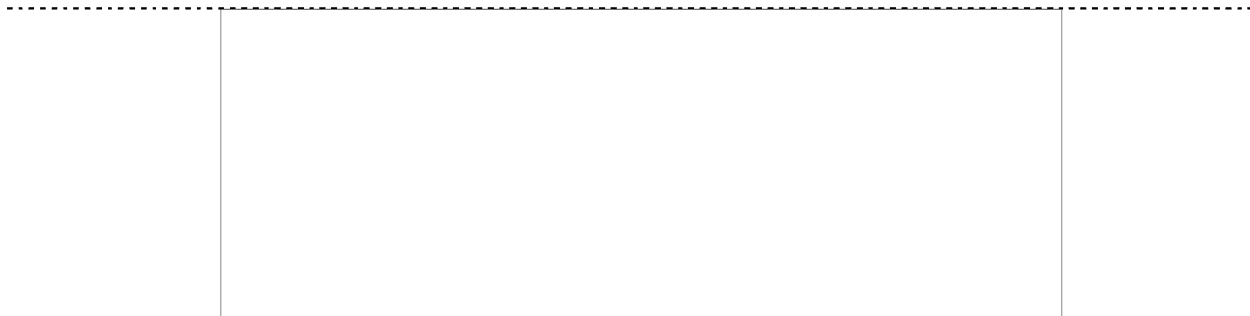
The third paper is a publication from Lisa Alexander, one of the faculty present at the meeting, head of the NP program here at GW.
