Cheryl, following up on this morning, I'd just reiterate the essential point that HRC case her message to the Indians as follows:

- $\cdot$  The U.S. is committed to working with India on a range of global as well as regional and bilateral issues, including issues having to do with nonproliferation.
- · In that realm, the Administration is committed to strengthening the NPT, of which India is not a part.

- The Administration is also committed to developing a broader global nonproliferation regime, of which we hope India will be a part.
- · What that means in practice is something our colleagues should work on in the months ahead.
- We are also committed to implementing the civilian nuclear cooperation agreement—but we want to find mutually acceptable ways of doing so in the context of the above.

Finally, regardless of who accompanies her on the trip, I'd suggest that you get a paper from Bob on this set of points—and, no doubt, others that he'll feel would prepare and protect her if, as I suspect, the Indians try to hem her in or cherry-pick what they like from what they don't like among the open issues on civ-nuke cooperation.
