Cheryl, by the way, is extraordinary -- focused, strategic, smart, frank. How [redacted]

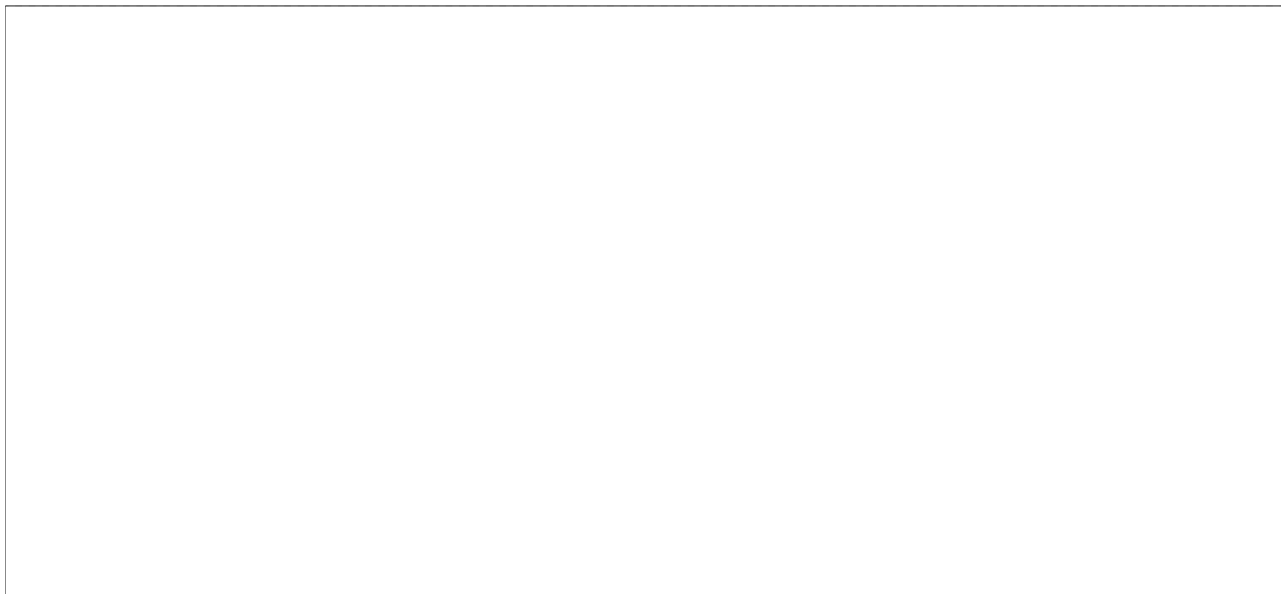

Hi Jan --

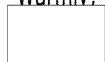
