Don't laugh me out of the room for this question: is it at all conceivable that [redacted] and is it known whether something else has already been proposed to him? The development assistance advocacy community is unusually unified at present around reform and he has been talked about extensively as possibly the one person who could put development assistance on a par with DoD and State. Sense is that he might do it if framed as a turn-around that could be accomplished in a year or two, as he might well not want this long-run. We hear over and over (and we concur) that USAID must be someone 1) of enormous stature; 2) capable of immediate traction/effectiveness on the hill, 3) high energy, capable leader-manager, 4) someone who cld function broadly as member of senior State team, with H confidence and trust right away.
