Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is in response to your 4 May 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally submitted by you to the Department of Defense Office of Inspector General (DODOIG), for "Request a copy of records (which includes videos/photos), electronic or otherwise, pertaining to Project No. D2021-DEVOSN-0116.000. This would include, but not limited to, the "evaluations" objectives, overview, communications about the setup of the project number, etc.". One document found to be responsive to your request was received in the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) by way of referral on 1 August 2024.

We have processed the referred document in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended and the NRO considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing this document and applying FOIA exemptions and this document is being released to you in part.

Material withheld from release is denied pursuant to FOIA exemptions:

(b)(1), as properly classified information under Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4(c), (e), and (g); and

(b) (3), which is the basis for withholding information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant withholding statute is 10 U.S.C. § 424, which provides (except as required by the President or for information provided to Congress), that no provision of law shall be construed to require the disclosure of the organization or any function of the NRO; the number of persons employed by or assigned or detailed to the NRO; or the name or official title, occupational series, grade, or salary of any such person.

You have the right to appeal this determination to the NRO Appellate Authority, 14675 Lee Road, Chantilly, VA 20151-1715, within

90 days of the above date. You may also submit an appeal electronically through the National FOIA Portal at <u>www.foia.gov</u> or via email to <u>FOIA@nro.mil</u>. Please include an explanation of the reason(s) for your appeal as part of your submission. The FOIA also provides that you may seek dispute resolution for any adverse determination through the NRO FOIA Public Liaison and/or through the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS). 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
