Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is a final response to FOIA request 21-F-1322, July 21, 2021, to the Office of the Secretary of Defense/Joint Staff (OSD/JS) FOIA office, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. We received your request from the Office of the Assistant to the Secretary of Defense for Privacy, Civil Liberties and Transparency on October 3, 2024, requesting an additional review of the responsive document provided to you. Your reopened request was assigned case number 21-FR-1322. Please use this reference number when referring to your request.

The Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence & Security, All-domain Anomaly Resolution Office, a component of OSD, and Defense Intelligence Agency conducted an additional review of the records. The Initial Denial Authorities have determined that portions of the two responsive pages are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552:

(b)(3), information specifically exempted by a statute establishing particular criteria for withholding, applying 10 USC § 130b which pertains to personnel in overseas, sensitive or routinely deployable units; and 5 U.S.C. 10 U.S.C. § 424 which pertains to organization or any function of an organization, and certain information pertaining to, employees of the Defense Intelligence Agency, the National Reconnaissance Office, and the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency; and

(b)(6), as disclosure of the information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals.

Please note that we have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying exemptions under the FOIA in the processing of this request. Additionally, in this instance, fees for processing your request were below the threshold for requiring payment. Please note that fees may be assessed on future requests.
