This is a final response to your October 12, 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. The Office of the Secretary of Defense/Joint Staff (OSD/JS) FOIA office received your request on October 12, 2021, and assigned it FOIA case number 22-F-0035. We ask that you use this number when referring to your request.

The Washington Headquarters Services, Executive Services Directorate, Defense Office of Prepublication and Security Review (DOPSR), a component of the Office of the Secretary of Defense, conducted a search of their records systems and located 106 pages determined to be responsive to your request. Mr. Paul J. Jacobsmeyer, Deputy, in his capacity as an Initial Denial Authority, has determined that portions of the 106 responsive pages are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552:

- (b)(4), trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5), inter- and intra- agency memoranda which are deliberative in nature; this exemption is appropriate for internal documents which are part of the decision-making process, and contain subjective evaluations, opinions and recommendations; and
- (b)(6), information which, if disclosed, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals.

Please note that we have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying exemptions under the FOIA in the processing of this request.

In this instance, fees for processing your request were below the threshold for requiring payment. Please note that fees may be assessed on future requests.

This email is to confirm the Defense Office of Prepublication and Security Review (DOPSR) has commenced prepublication review of your manuscript "Skinwalkers at the Pentagon", originally received on March 10, 2020. Thank you for resending the manuscript on April 30. DOPSR will conduct a security review for classified information, controlled unclassified information, operational security related information, and a policy review to ensure accurate statements of DoD Policy. I am the assigned action officer and the manuscript is assigned case number 20-SB-0058.

Manuscript reviews are averaging several months, and have been severely hampered by the current Pandemic mitigation measures that have affected the Department. DOPSR is currently on full-time telework and has reduced capabilities to complete manuscript reviews efficiently. Other factors affecting review times are the complexity of the subject matter, the volume of information, and the number of components with equity in the manuscript. DOPSR continues to strive to complete reviews in as timely a manner as possible.

DOPSR does not accommodate publishers' timelines, therefore, we recommend that you do not sign a contract with a publishing company, or provide copies of the manuscript to a publisher or other individuals until the review is complete.

As the author you will be solely responsible for the release of names, photos, and other personally identifiable information (PII) of active duty Service members, DoD employees, and third party individuals, the release of which could be a violation of the privacy rights of these individuals. If you have not done so already, you may wish to consult these individuals and obtain permission to include their PII in the manuscript.

Dear Mr. Lacatski:

This is in response to your April 23, 2020, correspondence requesting public release clearance of the manuscript titled, "Skinwalkers at the Pentagon: Correcting the Record". The manuscript submitted for prepublication security review is CLEARED AS AMENDED for public release. Enclosed are the pages of the manuscript with amendments. Amendments are clearly identified with blacked out text and red text boxes in the margins. Acceptable alternative language is provided for some of the amendments.

This clearance does not include any photograph, picture, exhibit, caption, or other supplemental material not specifically approved by this office, nor does this clearance imply Department of Defense (DoD) endorsement or factual accuracy of the material.

This office notes that your manuscript includes personally identifiable information (PII) and the protected health information (PHI) of former or active duty Service members, DoD employees, and third party individuals, the release of which could be a violation of the privacy rights of these individuals. The release of PHI could be a violation of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. As the author, you are solely responsible for the release of any PII and PHI and its legal implications. This office recommends that you rewrite the manuscript to eliminate all personal identifiers, including patient name, gender, and age. Alternatively, you may consult the individuals detailed in your manuscript and obtain permission to include their PII and PHI in the manuscript.

Additionally, DoD has concerns with the release of the names of Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) employees. The DoD requires that you obtain permission from the individuals to use their name associated with their DIA position or employment. Specifically, this pertains to Jonathan Axelrod, Susan Burch, and Chris Carlson.

This office requires that you add the following disclaimers prior to publishing the manuscript: "The views expressed in this publication are those of the author and do not necessarily reflect the official policy or position of the Department of Defense or the U.S. government." and; "The public release clearance of this publication by the Department of Defense does not imply Department of Defense endorsement or factual accuracy of the material."

If you are not satisfied with this response, you may request that this office reconsider the initial determination. Within 30 days of this response, provide any and all information or explanation of facts that you believe this office should know. You may include citations or copies of similar references that show this information was previously released and already in the public domain, although a mere listing of published citations may not necessarily be sufficient to reverse the initial determination. Please note the wide availability of certain information in open sources does not in and of itself constitute an official DoD or U.S. government acknowledgment, release, or declassification of the information. Additionally, you may rewrite portions of the redacted information and resubmit the manuscript for reconsideration.

You also have the right to appeal this response to the appellate authority. The appeal must offer written justification as described above to support the reversal of each required amendment being appealed. Appeals must be submitted within 60 days from the date of this response. Please submit any reconsiderations, rewrites, or appeals to: whs.pentagon.esd.mbx.secrev@mail.mil.

This clearance does not include any photograph, picture, exhibit, caption, or other supplemental material not specifically approved by this office, nor does this clearance imply Department of Defense (DoD) endorsement or factual accuracy of the material.

This office notes that your manuscript includes personally identifiable information (PII) and the protected health information (PHI) of former or active duty Service members, DoD employees, and third party individuals, the release of which could be a violation of the privacy rights of these individuals. The release of PHI could be a violation of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. You also have the right to appeal this response to the appellate authority. The appeal must offer written justification as described above to support the reversal of each required amendment being appealed.
