Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is a final response to your June 5, 2023 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. We received your request on June 5, 2023, and assigned it FOIA case number 23-F-0946. We ask that you use this number when referring to your request.

The Washington Headquarters Services, Executive Services Directorate, Defense Office of Prepublication and Security Review (DOPSR), a component of the Office of the Secretary of Defense, conducted a search of their records systems and located 15 pages determined to be responsive to your request. Mr. Paul Jacobsmeyer, Deputy Chief, DOPSR, in his capacity as an Initial Denial Authority, has determined that portions of the 15 responsive pages are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6), disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals. Please note that we have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying exemptions under the FOIA in the processing of this request.

In this instance, fees for processing your request were below the threshold for requiring payment. Please note that fees may be assessed on future requests.
