



HISTORY OVERVIEW

The holding company carries on the glorious history of an armoury founded in 1807 by the order of Emperor Alexander I. It manufactured most types of small arms in 19th and 20th centuries. During World War II, the total number of rifles and carbines manufactured by Izhevsk Weapons Plant exceeded total production of all German plants. During the two centuries, the company produced vast volumes of antitank rifles, aircraft machineguns, aircraft cannons, guns, handguns and other weapons.

After the WWII the plant launched mass production of Kalashnikov rifles that are still used by armies and special forces worldwide. Izhmash was established in 1975.

By 2008, Izhmash comprised over one hundred companies, some of which were on the verge of bankruptcy. In 2010, Russian Technologies carried out an audit which revealed a poor state of the holding company. Only 32 companies were actually operating with a multi-level management system, high overheads and doubled up functions. The combined liability of Izhmash in early 2011 was RUR 19 billion. The use of the existing modern equipment hardly exceeded 20%.

Russian Technologies took on the restructuring process through bankruptcy and merger. One of the objectives was to retain its research, industrial and human resources and to turn Izhmash into a leading global small arms manufacturer.

Izhmash was established in 2011 through assets consolidation, the process that finished in April 2012. As a result, there was a threefold increase in profits and a 10% cut in costs.

In a short time Izhmash managed to establish control over financial flows, improv production financing, payment systems and service of current payments.

In 2011, Izhmash increased the utilisation rate of modern multipurpose equipment from 20% to 70%. The effect from the efforts to enhance production performance amounts to RUR 100 million.

Izhmash revenues increased due to expanded distribution markets. Kalashnikov for free

Weapons designer Mikhail Kalashnikov gave his name to the new joint company formed on the basis of "Izhmash" and "Izhmeh." Despite the fact that manufacturers were willing to offer Kalashnikov from one and a half to three million rubles for the use of his name as a brand name, Kalashnikov gave it for free.

"Mikhail Kalashnikov is a patriot, a true patriot. There was not a single word about some kind of payment," *Interfax* quoted Director General of JSC NPO Izhmash Konstantin Busygin, who made a

statement last Friday at a press conference. Busygin also added that the documents were signed back in February.

It is assumed that the new concern, known as "Kalashnikov", will bring together largest enterprises of the Russian defense industry to manufacture a wide range of ammunition under a single brand. The merger should be completed within the next three months. Upon its completion, the company will receive the name "Concern "Kalashnikov."

Negotiations with the Kalashnikov family started last year. At the time the entity was entitled to use the name of the designer only for certain types of military products. Meanwhile, it seemed appropriate to substantially expand the range as it would be beneficial both for the plant

and Mikhail Kalashnikov, because the company would provide him with a steady income through the sale of products manufactured under his name. At the very least, this was the goal declared by "Izhmash". Now, however, the concern seems to be pleased with Kalashnikov's patriotism

that allowed the company to avoid paying him. It was noted earlier that the brand value of "Kalashnikov" was estimated at \$10 billion.

Mikhail Kalashnikov is a unique individual. Seventeenth child from a peasant family, Kalashnikov is now 93, and is famous around the globe. Since 1999, he has had the rank of lieutenant-general. Upon arrival somewhere with a visit, he is greeted like a movie star. Meanwhile, Kalashnikov lives in an ordinary house with no elevator, very modestly, without frills. He is nearly deaf because of trauma developed in shooting galleries and ranges during countless tests of his inventions. Despite the incredible demand for Kalashnikov's inventions, his design activities did not make him wealthy. This is not because Mikhail Kalashnikov failed to take advantage of the opportunities available to him, but because he did not want to do it. In the same way he did not use the opportunity to capitalize on his name, instead giving it as a gift.

Izhevsk Machine-Building Plant (NPO "Izhmash") produces various types of military firearms, sporting and hunting guns, air guns, precision-guided artillery shells, control systems, as well as machines and high-quality tools. There are Kalashnikovs among its products, in particular, modernized Kalashnikov, AK-74M, AK-9, and "one-hundredth-series" Kalashnikovs.

Izhevsk Mechanical Plant (JSC "Izhmeh") is also engaged in production of weapons, both civilian and service ones. In addition, the plant produces power tools, packaging equipment, gas equipment, medical equipment and precise steel castings. However, the basis of its production is still military and hunting weapons. In particular, "Izhmeh" produces the most common hunting rifle in Russia - IZH-27.

In addition to these two major companies, it is assumed that Kalashnikov company will also include other large entities. In particular, Vyatsko-Polyansky plant "Molot", located in the Kirov region. This company also manufactures military and civilian arms, including Kalashnikov RPK light machine gun and Kalashnikov RPK-74machine gun.





Rostec to transfer the control over IMZ to private investors

The Corporation will retain a blocking stake



Andrey Bokarev will acquire 74.9% of IMZ (Izhevsky Mekhanichesky Zavod) shares owned by Rostec Corporation. The purchase price will be allocated for production modernization and reequipment of manufacturing funds. Rostec will retain controlling interest.

The purchase will be made after corporate approval procedures are fulfilled through additional IMZ shares emission and will have two stages. 51% of shares will pass to private investors the first quarter of 2015, and the rest of the stock will be purchased later. The shares will be acquired by one of the companies controlled by Bokarev.

Recently Rostec has revised the strategy of several holdings. Sporting gun and pistol manufacturer IMZ is a Corporation's non-core asset. The reequipment requires substantial investments, engineering processes need to be arranged. Market competences and private investor experience will contribute to the plant's sustainable development. However, Rostec will retain controlling interest.

The total price is to be defined after independent appraisal of IMZ value, 100% of which are owned by Rostec for now.

Andrey Bokarev has vast experience in the industrial production. Transmashholding co-owned by Andrey Bokarev manufactures diesel engines for submarines, mainline and industrial electric locomotives, main line and diesel-locomotive shunters, freight and passenger cars, electric trains and subway cars, car casting, diesel locomotive and marine engines, diesel-electric engines, components for railroad rolling stocks and city railroad transport.

The company's share in the Russian small arm market is about 50%. The plant produces a whole range of civilian weapons such as smoothbore and rifled hunting weapons, air rifles and pistols, sporting and service weapons, limit-target firearms. The most popular weapons are classical smoothbore hunting weapons, self-loading and air weapons.

The share of exports in the plant's revenues is over 25%. Key IMZ importers are Germany, Cyprus, the USA.

Today, IMZ is on the verge of unprofitableness. Revenues for 2013 were RUR 3 bln, loss – RUR 182 mln. The company needs to realize a large-scale investment program to drastically change the situation. New investors will help revive the plant.



Equipped with a shiny new logo and claiming its guns are "protecting peace", the Russian weapons manufacturer Kalashnikov launched a major rebranding drive in Moscow on Tuesday. Kalashnikov Concern, a new overarching brand that includes the famed assault rifles as well as hunting and sports weaponry, paid a leading Russian agency to design a new brand and renew its worldwide image.

"The Kalashnikov is a Russian symbol that is known across the world," said Alexei Krivoruchko, Kalashnikov's chief executive "The rebranding is a symbol of changes in the way our business works and our product lines that have been long in the making. The new brand will reflect our main principles: reliability, responsibility and technological efficiency "

The company's most famous gun was developed by the Soviet engineer Mikhail Kalashnikov in 1947 and quickly became a mainstay of wars and civil conflicts across the world, known for its ease of use and reliability. The weapons are manufactured at a plant in Izhevsk, a city in Russia's Urals region

A slickly produced marketing video produced for the launch of the new brand describes the Kalashnikov as a "weapon of peace"



"The gun was made for the defence of a country that was living through the cold war and had to be prepared for a major intervention," says the video voiceover "The simple and reliable AK was also in demand well beyond the borders of the Soviet Union

"It precipitated not just a technological but a social revolution Freedom movements in Africa, Asia and Latin America could at last fight back against professional colonial armies The AK-47 gave them the chance to demand rights and achieve justice This is a weapon which helped people defend their families and futures, and demand the right to a peaceful future"

A second video features a reconstruction of a Russian special forces operation against terrorist suspects in the northern Caucasus, with dramatic music in the background and statistics flashing up about how many terrorists have been "liquidated" by Russian troops in recent years. It ends with the phrase: "Kalashnikov: promoting peace and calm"



Krivoruchko said on Tuesday that a huge contract to supply up to 200,000 weapons a year to the US and Canada is still on hold after Washington slapped sanctions on Russian defence companies including Kalashnikov over the summer, in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine The US accuses Russia of backing the insurgency in east Ukraine, where Kalashnikov rifles are used both by the insurgents and the Ukrainian forces

Kalashnikov was meant to supply between 80,000 and 200,000 sporting rifles and shotguns annually to a US importer for the next five years, under an agreement signed in January, but Krivoruchko said not a single gun had been delivered Instead, the firm is exploring new markets in Asia



State-owned Russian Technologies, or Rostec, confirmed on Monday the sale of a 49 percent stake in arms maker Kalashnikov Corporation to private investors for 2.5 billion rubles (\$75 million).

MOSCOW, September 23 (RIA Novosti) – State-owned Russian Technologies, or Rostec, confirmed on Monday the sale of a 49 percent stake in arms maker Kalashnikov Corporation to private investors for 2.5 billion rubles (\$75 million).

The stake has gone to a joint venture set up by Andrei Bochkarev, co-owner of Transmashinkholding and Kuzbassrazrezugol, and Alexei Krivoruchko, head of Aeroexpress, Rostec said in a statement.

Rostec will retain a 51 percent stake in the corporation. The 2.5 billion rubles will be invested within the next two years and spent on development projects, Rostec said.


The deal has received President Vladimir Putin's blessing, according to a defense industry source cited by the Kommersant newspaper.

The investment should pay back within five years, Krivoruchko was quoted by Kommersant as saying.

"Our plans include a significant increase in manufacturing capacity. In particular, we are interested in establishing joint ventures with foreign partners for the production of gunpowder and ammunition," he said.

Russia's Izhmash arms factory, manufacturer of the legendary Kalashnikov assault rifle, was renamed Kalashnikov Corporation in mid-August and will soon integrate several other defense plants into the new holding. It will include Izhmash, Izhmekh and some other small-arms manufacturers under the famed Kalashnikov brand.

Izhmash produces over 70 types of weapons, including firearms, aircraft guns, and artillery shells, as well as a variety of sporting and hunting weapons. The company won a \$400









million Russian government contract in July to produce Vikhr anti-armor missiles. Izhmekh is best known for its Makarov and Yarygin pistols.

However, both companies have been recently experiencing financial difficulties and a sharp drop in production output. The government is now hoping to revive them by merging them under the new brand.

Mikhail Kalashnikov, 93, the designer of the Kalashnikov assault rifle, personally authorized the use of his name for the new corporation in February.


