Dear John Greenwald:

Reference is made to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (USSS) on July 14, 2023, for a copy of records (which includes videos/photos), electronic or otherwise, pertaining to the recent investigation into cocaine found at the White House on or around July 2, 2023.

In our previous final response letter, it was indicated 34 pages had been withheld in full. However, after additional review, only 25 pages were withheld. We have since re-reviewed those 25 pages and are releasing all of them; with some subject to redactions pursuant to identified FOIA exemptions. A copy of these pages is attached.

Exemptions under the FOIA Statute, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552, and/or the PA Statute, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552a, have been applied where deemed appropriate after considering the foreseeable harm standard outline in the 2016 amendment to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (a)(8)(A)(i) and DOJ guidance.

Enclosed are the documents responsive to your request, as well as a document that explains the exemptions in more detail. Withheld information is pursuant to the exemptions marked in bold below.
