Dear Requester:

This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (Secret Service) on October 5, 2023, for information pertaining to a copy of records (which includes videos/photos), electronic or otherwise, pertaining "Commander" – the dog who lives in the White House, including, but do not limit to, all memos, letters, reports, photographs, videos, and emails pertaining to "Commander" and the biting incidents.

After a detailed review of all potentially responsive records, 222 pages were released and 0 pages were withheld in their entirety. After considering the "Foreseeable Harm" standard, outlined in Title 5 U.S.C § 552(a)(8)(A)(i) and Department of Justice guidance, exemptions under FOIA Statute Title 5 U.S.C. § 552, and/or the PA Statute Title 5 U.S.C. § 552a, have been applied where deemed appropriate.

Enclosed are the documents responsive to your request, as well as a document that explains the exemptions in more detail. Withheld information is pursuant to the exemptions marked below.



Sept. 26 (UPI) -- President <u>Joe Biden</u>'s 2-year-old German shepherd, Commander, has bitten another Secret Service agent in what is the dog's 11th known attack.

Commander bit the officer Monday evening at the White House, according to a statement from the Secret Service.

"Yesterday around 8 p.m., a Secret Service Uniformed Division police officer came in contact with a First Family pet and was bitten," USSS chief of communications <u>Anthony Guglielmi</u> said. "The officer was treated by medical personnel on complex."

Guglielmi added that Secret Service spoke Tuesday with the injured agent, who said she was doing fine.

The Bidens' other <u>German Shepherd</u>, <u>Major</u>, <u>also bit</u> Secret Service, White House staff and a National Park Service employee shortly after the president took office. Despite training and time for "Major to adjust to his new surroundings," according to the White House, he was <u>sent back to</u> Delaware to live with friends.

Commander <u>arrived at the White House</u> as a gift from family in December 2021, after Major moved out.

The Bidens' other German Shepherd Champ -- who <u>passed away</u> six months earlier at the age of 13 -- was not involved in any biting incidents.

According to Judicial Watch, Secret service records <u>reveal 10 attacks</u> -- before Monday's incident -- by Commander over a four-month period between October 2022 and January. Judicial Watch forced the release of the records through a Freedom of Information Act lawsuit, regarding "incidents of aggression and bites involving the Biden family dog, Commander."

In October, a Secret Service agent warned colleagues about Commander in an email.

"Commander has been exhibiting extremely aggressive behavior. Today, while posted, he came charging at me. The first lady couldn't regain control of Commander and he continued to circle me. I believe it's only a matter of time before an agent/officer is attacked or bit," the agent wrote on Oct. 26.

One week later, an agent was transported to the hospital after Commander bit him in the upper right arm and on the thigh. The officer was placed on "restricted duty status" for three days on doctors' advice.

In December, a Secret Service agent said he was attacked on the South Lawn of the White House after President Biden let Commander off his leash.

"The injuries included a bite to the left forearm, resulting in bruising, and approximately a 1.5 cm cut and a bite to the right hand on the thumb resulting in a 1 cm cut. I received treatment from White House Medical," the agent said before returning to work the rest of his shift.



Commander Biden bites another Secret Service agent, the 11th known incident

<u>President Joe Biden</u>'s younger dog, Commander, bit another US Secret Service agent at the White House Monday evening, CNN has learned, the 11th known biting incident involving the 2-year-old German Shepherd.

"Yesterday around 8 p.m., a Secret Service Uniformed Division police officer came in contact with a First Family pet and was bitten. The officer was treated by medical personnel on complex," USSS chief of communications Anthony Guglielmi told CNN in a statement.

The injured officer spoke with Secret Service Director Kimberly Cheatle on Tuesday and is doing OK, Guglielmi said.

Commander has been involved in at least 11 biting incidents at the White House and in Delaware, according to CNN reporting and US Secret Service email correspondence, including a November 2022 incident where an officer was hospitalized after the dog clamped down on their arms and thighs.

White House officials said in July that the Bidens were working through new training and leashing protocols for the family pet following the incidents.

The office of the first lady did not immediately respond to CNN's request for comment Tuesday on whether that training had taken place or if any further action would be sought. Another of Biden's <u>dogs</u>, <u>Major</u>, <u>was involved</u>in biting incidents at the White House.

The <u>German Shepherd</u> later moved out of the White House, and Commander arrived <u>at</u> the White House in 2021.

The July email correspondence, obtained through Freedom of Information Act requests by the conservative group Judicial Watch, reflected 10 incidents.

In one incident in October, first lady Dr. Jill Biden "couldn't regain control" of the dog as it charged a member of Secret Service staff.

"I believe it's only a matter of time before an agent/officer is attacked or bit," the staff member warned in an email.

Elizabeth Alexander, communications director for the first lady, said at the time that the first family has been "partnering with the Secret Service and Executive Residence staff on additional leashing protocols and training, as well as establishing designated areas for Commander to run and exercise."

While Secret Service agents are not responsible for the handling of the first family's pets, they can come into frequent contact with the animals.

"This isn't a Secret Service thing. This is a this is a workplace safety issue," CNN contributor and former USSS agent Jonathan Wackrow told CNN.

"There's uniqueness here where it's the residence of the president of the United States, but it's also the workplace for hundreds, thousands of people. And you can't bring a hazard into the workplace. And that's what is essentially happening with this dog. One time you can say it's an accident, but now multiple incidents, it's a serious issue," he added.

Wackrow called it a "significant hazard" for agents on duty at the White House residence.

"I'm sure that the Bidens love the dog. I'm sure that it's a member of the family like every dog is, but you're creating a significant hazard to those who support you – support the office of the president," he said.





I'm working on some follow up reporting on the Commander Biden biting situation and hoping for your insight on a few outstanding questions.

- Do you have an exact number you can share of how many biting incidents have occurred with Commander and USSS personnel? My understanding based on my reporting is that the number is significantly higher than 11. One source told me that they were told there were 34 different instances in a 90-day period this summer. Do you have an approximate ballpark of total incidents? More or less than 50? More or less than 100? 200?
- What do you say to your own USSS personnel who say that this is creating a "hostile" and "dangerous" work environment? Agents have been warning each other to go through certain entrances and avoid other areas to stay away from Commander – what's your response to that?
- Has the USSS raised this issue directly with the president or first lady?
- Have any of these bites been reported to the DC Health Department as outlined in DC code? (I understand the DC Council doesn't have jurisdiction over federal lands, but some experts argue the lack of federal guidance on these situations could lead to DC code applying.)
- Are you aware of any USSS involvement in instances beyond USSS, specifically residence staff? I'm hearing of biting situations with an engineer and with an usher. Anything else you can share on that?

Joe Biden's tension with his Secret Service detail goes back to his years as vice president when he made female agents uncomfortable by skinny-dipping in front of them but it's gotten worse during his White House years after his German Shepherds bit several agents.

Biden's new two-year-old dog Commander has bitten at least a dozen agents plus people who work in the White House residence, requiring some to get medical attention. And the first couple's former dog Major was so aggressive and prone to biting that he was rehomed to friends in Delaware.

'It's outrageous, just outrageous for those agents who risk their lives every day to protect the president,' Ronald Kessler, the author of several books on the Secret Service, told DailyMail.com. 'They never know when they're gonna get shot and they have to put up with the fear of being bitten by a dog. It's just unthinkable that it went on this long.'

Commander has been moved off campus, living at an undisclosed location. Earlier, DailyMail.com published exclusive photos showing the dog biting the superintendent of the White House grounds on September 13.

The Bidens' relationship with the Secret Service is now 'combustible,' a source told CNN, citing the tensions with the first pets, constant schedule changes and other issues.

The Secret Service denied there were any problems.

'On this I can say with firsthand knowledge that it is categorically false. There is an immense degree of trust and respect between the Secret Service and the first family and we know those feelings are mutual,' Secret Service spokesman Anthony Guglielmi told DailyMail.com in a statement.

The Bidens were also said to be suspicious of their agents, many of whom they suspected supported Donald Trump.

The tensions are said to have started during Biden's time as vice president, and to have continued in his early days in the White House.

'Agents say that, whether at the vice president's residence or at his home in Delaware, Biden has a habit of swimming in his pool nude,'

Kessler wrote in his book, The First Family Detail: Secret Service Agents Reveal the Hidden Lives of the Presidents.

'Female Secret Service agents find that offensive,' he noted.

Kessler also outlined the agents' frustration with Biden's constantlychanging schedule and frequent trips to his home in Wilmington, Delaware.

'He would never give agents any kind of pre-warning of what his schedule was going to be,' Kessler told DailyMail.com. 'He would just, on the spur of the moment, decide to go back to Wilmington, frequently, more than once a week. And so they could never plan their lives. They could never set up a social occasion.'

He noted agents considered Biden duty the 'second worst assignment.' The top spot went to being on Hillary Clinton's detail.

The mistrust goes both ways.

The Bidens were also said to be suspicious of their agents, many of whom they suspected supported Donald Trump.

A level of trust is important, given the close quarters. Agents shadow the first couple wherever they go, often overhearing private conversations and witnessing private moments.

'It seems to me that it's it's critical,' Christopher Whipple, author of The Fight for His Life: Inside Joe Biden's White House, told DailyMail.com. 'For the most obvious reasons that the President's safety depends upon it.'

'But I think I think he also has a right to assume that the Secret Service check their politics at the door and that he can have confidential conversations without worrying about whether there's a MAGA sympathizer that will report that to someone else.'

The Bidens aren't the first presidential couple to worry about the agents' political ties. The Clintons were worried their detail were still loyal to George W. Bush and his family.

Additionally, adjusting to the fishbowl life in the White House - where agents

and staff are around 24/7 - can be difficult for every first couple. Even Melania Trump, who had a large staff and private security when she lived at Trump Tower, was said to find life in the White House stifling.

But the recent spate of dog bites have ratcheted up the tension.

Commander was a birthday gift to the president from James and Sara Biden, his brother and sister-in-law, and first came to the White House on December 20, 2021.

The pet's biting record was released in July when a conservative group used a Freedom of Information Act request to obtain emails from Secret Service officials.

It was revealed the 2-year-old German Shepherd has bitten at least a dozen Secret Service agents. Later reports found he also went after staff in the residence.

And the Bidens' earlier dog Major was so aggressive that residence officials warned Jill Biden's office the Bidens could face a lawsuit for injuries unless there were changes, Axios reported.

Major was eventually given to Biden friends in Delaware.

When at the White House, Commander lives upstairs with the first couple. Jill Biden walks him in the mornings and when she is at home. Otherwise Dale Haney, the longtime groundskeeper takes him out, or residence staff do so.

German shepherds can be aggressive and are known to defend those they consider family.

The Biden administration has defended the dog. Jill Biden's office has noted that the White House 'can be a stressful environment for family pets, and the First Family continues to work on ways to help Commander handle the often unpredictable nature of the White House grounds.'

But a former White House official who regularly interacted with both Commander and Major told Axios: 'The first family and their inner circle refuse to engage in any problem-solving discussions to protect the agents and [Executive Residence] staff.'

'The ongoing discipline issue of the Biden dogs is in no way a Secret Service

problem. The agency is just trying to protect their own agents from these animals who do have violent behaviors.'

President Joe Biden had entered the White House with two German Shepherds, Champ ¿ who died in 2021 ¿ and Major who was removed that year

The incident, which was unwittingly captured on camera by a tourist snapping photos on September 13, shows the two-year-old German Shepherd sinking its teeth into the groundskeeper Dale Haney's left arm

The White House has claimed that 'everyone loves' Commander.

White House press secretary Karine Jean-Pierre said Thursday that she has never felt threatened by the dog.

'I've seen Commander many times. I was never worried. And I've never been bitten by Commander,' she said.

'As it relates to me, I was never wary of Commander. I've seen him many, many times. And so I can only speak for myself though, and I can't speak to anything else outside of that,' she added.

White House officials said the Bidens were working through new training for Commander.

Commander Biden bites another Secret Service agent, the 11th known incident

<u>President Joe Biden</u>'s younger dog, Commander, bit another US Secret Service agent at the White House Monday evening, CNN has learned, the 11th known biting incident involving the 2-year-old German Shepherd.

"Yesterday around 8 p.m., a Secret Service Uniformed Division police officer came in contact with a First Family pet and was bitten. The officer was treated by medical personnel on complex," USSS chief of communications Anthony Guglielmi told CNN in a statement.

The injured officer spoke with Secret Service Director Kimberly Cheatle on Tuesday and is doing OK, Guglielmi said.

Commander has been involved in at least 11 biting incidents at the White House and in Delaware, according to CNN reporting and US Secret Service email correspondence, including a November 2022 incident where an officer was hospitalized after the dog clamped down on their arms and thighs.

White House officials said in July that the Bidens were working through new training and leashing protocols for the family pet following the incidents.

The office of the first lady did not immediately respond to CNN's request for comment Tuesday on whether that training had taken place or if any further action would be sought. Another of Biden's <u>dogs</u>, <u>Major</u>, <u>was involved</u>in biting incidents at the White House.

The <u>German Shepherd</u> later moved out of the White House, and Commander arrived <u>at</u> the White House in 2021.

The July email correspondence, obtained through Freedom of Information Act requests by the conservative group Judicial Watch, reflected 10 incidents.

In one incident in October, first lady Dr. Jill Biden "couldn't regain control" of the dog as it charged a member of Secret Service staff.

"I believe it's only a matter of time before an agent/officer is attacked or bit," the staff member warned in an email.

Elizabeth Alexander, communications director for the first lady, said at the time that the first family has been "partnering with the Secret Service and Executive Residence staff on additional leashing protocols and training, as well as establishing designated areas for Commander to run and exercise."

While Secret Service agents are not responsible for the handling of the first family's pets, they can come into frequent contact with the animals.

"This isn't a Secret Service thing. This is a this is a workplace safety issue," CNN contributor and former USSS agent Jonathan Wackrow told CNN.

"There's uniqueness here where it's the residence of the president of the United States, but it's also the workplace for hundreds, thousands of people. And you can't bring a hazard into the workplace. And that's what is essentially happening with this dog. One time you can say it's an accident, but now multiple incidents, it's a serious issue," he added.

Wackrow called it a "significant hazard" for agents on duty at the White House residence.

"I'm sure that the Bidens love the dog. I'm sure that it's a member of the family like every dog is, but you're creating a significant hazard to those who support you – support the office of the president," he said.

Kessler wrote in his book, The First Family Detail: Secret Service Agents Reveal the Hidden Lives of the Presidents.

'Female Secret Service agents find that offensive,' he noted.

Kessler also outlined the agents' frustration with Biden's constantlychanging schedule and frequent trips to his home in Wilmington, Delaware.

'He would never give agents any kind of pre-warning of what his schedule was going to be,' Kessler told DailyMail.com. 'He would just, on the spur of the moment, decide to go back to Wilmington, frequently, more than once a week. And so they could never plan their lives. They could never set up a social occasion.'

He noted agents considered Biden duty the 'second worst assignment.' The top spot went to being on Hillary Clinton's detail.

The mistrust goes both ways.

The Bidens were also said to be suspicious of their agents, many of whom they suspected supported Donald Trump.

A level of trust is important, given the close quarters. Agents shadow the first couple wherever they go, often overhearing private conversations and witnessing private moments.

'It seems to me that it's it's critical,' Christopher Whipple, author of The Fight for His Life: Inside Joe Biden's White House, told DailyMail.com. 'For the most obvious reasons that the President's safety depends upon it.'

'But I think I think he also has a right to assume that the Secret Service check their politics at the door and that he can have confidential conversations without worrying about whether there's a MAGA sympathizer that will report that to someone else.'

The Bidens aren't the first presidential couple to worry about the agents' political ties. The Clintons were worried their detail were still loyal to George W. Bush and his family.

Additionally, adjusting to the fishbowl life in the White House - where agents

and staff are around 24/7 - can be difficult for every first couple. Even Melania Trump, who had a large staff and private security when she lived at Trump Tower, was said to find life in the White House stifling.

But the recent spate of dog bites have ratcheted up the tension.

Commander was a birthday gift to the president from James and Sara Biden, his brother and sister-in-law, and first came to the White House on December 20, 2021.

The pet's biting record was released in July when a conservative group used a Freedom of Information Act request to obtain emails from Secret Service officials.

It was revealed the 2-year-old German Shepherd has bitten at least a dozen Secret Service agents. Later reports found he also went after staff in the residence.

And the Bidens' earlier dog Major was so aggressive that residence officials warned Jill Biden's office the Bidens could face a lawsuit for injuries unless there were changes, Axios reported.

Major was eventually given to Biden friends in Delaware.

When at the White House, Commander lives upstairs with the first couple. Jill Biden walks him in the mornings and when she is at home. Otherwise Dale Haney, the longtime groundskeeper takes him out, or residence staff do so.

German shepherds can be aggressive and are known to defend those they consider family.

The Biden administration has defended the dog. Jill Biden's office has noted that the White House 'can be a stressful environment for family pets, and the First Family continues to work on ways to help Commander handle the often unpredictable nature of the White House grounds.'

But a former White House official who regularly interacted with both Commander and Major told Axios: 'The first family and their inner circle refuse to engage in any problem-solving discussions to protect the agents and [Executive Residence] staff.'

'The ongoing discipline issue of the Biden dogs is in no way a Secret Service

problem. The agency is just trying to protect their own agents from these animals who do have violent behaviors.'





Sept. 26 (UPI) -- President <u>Joe Biden</u>'s 2-year-old German shepherd, Commander, has bitten another Secret Service agent in what is the dog's 11th known attack.

Commander bit the officer Monday evening at the White House, according to a statement from the Secret Service.

"Yesterday around 8 p.m., a Secret Service Uniformed Division police officer came in contact with a First Family pet and was bitten," USSS chief of communications <u>Anthony Guglielmi</u> said. "The officer was treated by medical personnel on complex."

Guglielmi added that Secret Service spoke Tuesday with the injured agent, who said she was doing fine.

The Bidens' other <u>German Shepherd</u>, <u>Major</u>, <u>also bit</u> Secret Service, White House staff and a National Park Service employee shortly after the president took office. Despite training and time for "Major to adjust to his new surroundings," according to the White House, he was <u>sent back to Delaware</u> to live with friends.

Commander <u>arrived at the White House</u> as a gift from family in December 2021, after Major moved out.

The Bidens' other German Shepherd Champ -- who <u>passed away</u> six months earlier at the age of 13 -- was not involved in any biting incidents.

According to Judicial Watch, Secret service records <u>reveal 10 attacks</u> -- before Monday's incident -- by Commander over a four-month period between October 2022 and January. Judicial Watch forced the release of the records through a Freedom of Information Act lawsuit, regarding "incidents of aggression and bites involving the Biden family dog, Commander."

In October, a Secret Service agent warned colleagues about Commander in an email.

"Commander has been exhibiting extremely aggressive behavior. Today, while posted, he came charging at me. The first lady couldn't regain control of Commander and he continued to circle me. I believe it's only a matter of time before an agent/officer is attacked or bit," the agent wrote on Oct. 26.

One week later, an agent was transported to the hospital after Commander bit him in the upper right arm and on the thigh. The officer was placed on "restricted duty status" for three days on doctors' advice.

In December, a Secret Service agent said he was attacked on the South Lawn of the White House after President Biden let Commander off his leash.

"The injuries included a bite to the left forearm, resulting in bruising, and approximately a 1.5 cm cut and a bite to the right hand on the thumb

resulting in a 1 cm cut. I received treatment from White House Medical," the agent said before returning to work the rest of his shift.

Hi Anthony,

I'm working on some follow up reporting on the Commander Biden biting situation and hoping for your insight on a few outstanding questions.

- Do you have an exact number you can share of how many biting incidents have occurred with Commander and USSS personnel? My understanding based on my reporting is that the number is significantly higher than 11. One source told me that they were told there were 34 different instances in a 90-day period this summer. Do you have an approximate ballpark of total incidents? More or less than 50? More or less than 100? 200?
- What do you say to your own USSS personnel who say that this is creating a "hostile" and "dangerous" work environment? Agents have been warning each other to go through certain entrances and avoid other areas to stay away from Commander – what's your response to that?
- Has the USSS raised this issue directly with the president or first lady?
- Have any of these bites been reported to the DC Health Department as outlined in DC code? (I understand the DC Council doesn't have jurisdiction over federal lands, but some experts argue the lack of federal guidance on these situations could lead to DC code applying.)
- Are you aware of any USSS involvement in instances beyond USSS, specifically residence staff? I'm hearing of biting situations with an engineer and with an usher. Anything else you can share on that?


